



Assembly Instructions

SQUARE HERB BOX SLOT TOGETHER RAISED BED KITS

We recommend that you read these instructions thoroughly before starting assembly; familiarise yourself with the process and double check you have the correct components and the recommended tools to complete the job. We highly recommend that any assembly is carried out on an open flat, level surface if possible with sufficient space.

Assembly of these kits can be done by a single person, although an additional pair of hands will make it quicker and easier.



TOOLS REQUIRED

- No Tools Required
- Rubber Mallet/Soft Hammer (Recommended)

COMPONENTS

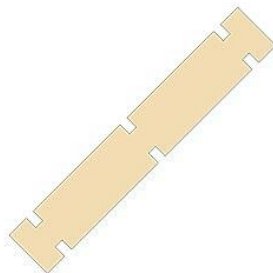
The components listed below are those required to build one of the three available kit tiers and all kits will come with a selection of full width and half width timbers.

Single Tier Kit Components

6x Half Width Notched/Slotted Timbers
(size depending on kit)



3x Full Width Notched/Slotted Timbers
(size depending on kit)

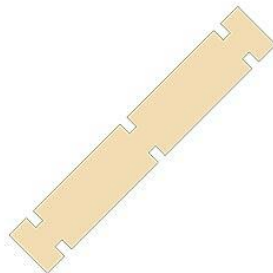


Two Tier Kit Components

6x Half Width Notched/Slotted Timbers
(size depending on kit)



9x Full Width Notched/Slotted Timbers
(size depending on kit)

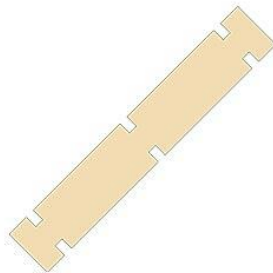


Three Tier Kit Components

6x Half Width Notched/Slotted Timbers
(size depending on kit)



15x Full Width Notched/Slotted Timbers
(size depending on kit)



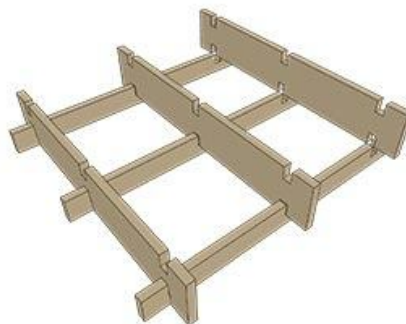
STEPS FOR SINGLE TIER KIT

STEP 1



Begin by placing three of the provided half width timbers equally apart, enough so that they would make an even square.

STEP 2



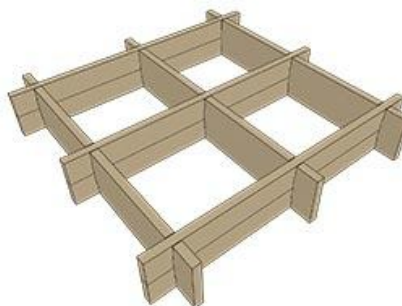
Next you will need to line-up and slot in the three full width timbers into the three pieces previously placed and ensure they are fully seated in the slots.

STEP 3



Slot in the last three half width timbers to complete the kit. We recommend using a rubber mallet and softly tapping on all corners to ensure the slots/joints are all fully seated.

STEP 4 - FINAL



The kit has now been fully assembled and it can be used as intended. Although we do not supply any fixings, and they're not necessary, at this point you can use some fixings to further secure the kit together (with Oak we recommend only using stainless steel).

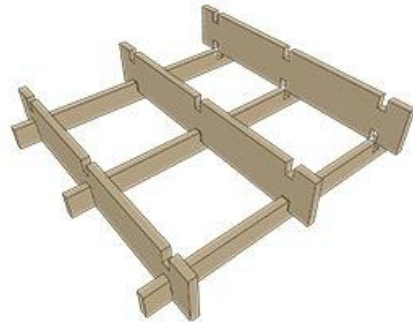
STEPS FOR MULTI TIER KIT

STEP 1



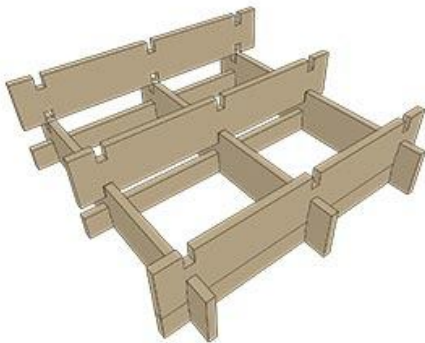
Begin by placing three of the provided half width timbers equally apart, enough so that they would make an even square.

STEP 2



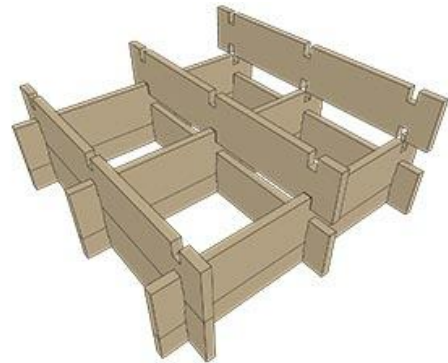
Next you will need to line-up and slot in three of the full width timbers into the three pieces previously placed and ensure they are fully seated in the slots.

STEP 3



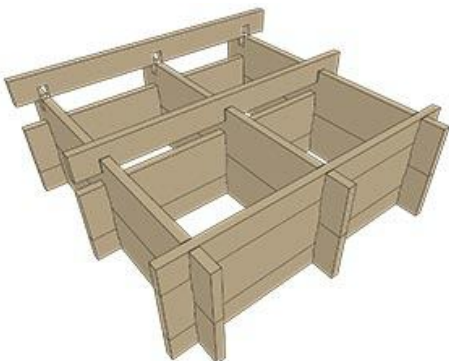
Next, line-up and slot in the next three full width timbers ensuring they are fully seated in the slots.

STEP 4



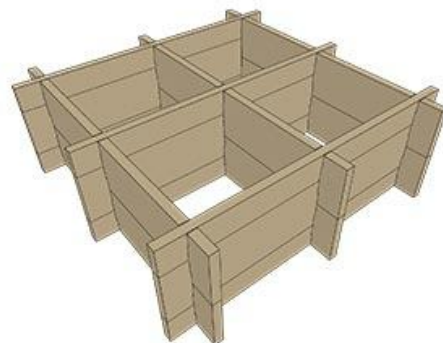
Like step 2, slot in three more of the full width timbers, again ensuring they're fully seated. (Repeat step 3 to 4 once more for three tier kits)

STEP 5



Slot in the last three half width timbers to complete the kit. We recommend using a rubber mallet and softly tapping on all corners to ensure the slots/joints are all fully seated.

STEP 6 - FINAL



The kit has now been fully assembled and it can be used as intended. Although we do not supply any fixings, and they're not necessary, at this point you can use some fixings to further secure the kit together (with Oak we recommend only using stainless steel).
